- Call to Order: Bob Sterner;
- Approval of Minutes, March 3, 2023 session Steve Evert;
 - Approved: Brian Alford;
 - Second: Yvonne Vaillancourt;
- Treasurer Report Michael Jacob;
 - NEAMGLL Statement of Activities reviewed;
 - Current Balance (per Lou 10/4/2023) reviewed;
 - Jacob does not have access to the bank account and therefore cannot verify that these numbers are correct;
 - Annual Budget: approximately \$6,000-\$7,000;
 - Current Balance: \$42,790.00;
 - Process per the ByLaws reviewed regarding the role of the Finance Committee;
 - Duties of the Treasurer reviewed from text on website;
 - Michael cannot accomplish all of these duties because of lack of access to the bank account; Tax filing has transitioned to NAML level; therefore this is a result of a transitional period;
 - Recommendation: Need to update the Bylaws due to the change in structure;
 - Michael: Intends to resign as Treasurer;
 - Action Item: need to elect a new treasurer in the near future;
 - Determine the target balance to carry-over in the bank account each year;
 - Board discuss and finance committee will take action;
 - Review what are the other NAML organizations doing;
 - Action Item: Review Bylaws.
- Student Awards Program
 - 2023: 2nd annual student awards program;
 - Total requests from applications: \$12,000;
 - o Committee included: Bob Sterner, Steve Evert, Charles Tilburg, Jeanette Schnars;
 - Awarded: \$5,000 (2 awards to work at other NEAMGLL labs; 7 conference travel awards);
 - 9 NEAMGLL students received some funding.
- NEAMGLL Future
 - Meetings:
 - Next meeting during Spring Public Policy Meeting?
 - Discussion: in one year schedule another in-person/hybrid annual meeting?
 - There is value in meeting in person and seeing other field stations;
 - Could NEAMGLL funds be used to help support the meeting and/or travel;
 - There is value is seeing how other field stations are solving similar problems; tour of other member labs incorporated into the meeting;

- Rotate between Northeast and Great Lakes;
- Registration Fee it is typically modest and supports the cost of the meeting;
 - Is there also a way to offset some of the expense?
- There is value to hybrid meeting;
- Budget needed to host the meeting;
 - Budgeted \$1,000; which covers food and other expenses; however, does not cover the hybrid technology which is a significant cost;
 - Host institutions will have to help support the meeting; meetings are not revenue generating;
 - Next year need to budget more to cover costs;
 - Next year meet in-person/hybrid and discuss if future meetings are in person yearly or every-other year;

- According to Bylaws, it is up to the board where the meeting is located;
 - Develop an ad hoc Meeting Committee? What is the role of the committee?

 - Elect: Member at Large;
 - Nominating Committee will forward nominations to group.
 - Election 2025
 - NEAMGLL needs to identify a nomination for President of NAML.
- Discussion: NEAMGLL Future What can NEAMGLL do for you?
 - Future meeting: include Ship Captains and Operations Staff at Field Stations/Marine Labs;
 - Next NEAMGLL Meeting Student presentations (virtual, speed talks);
 - NAML meeting (tomorrow) will have student presentations supported by NEAMGLL and SAML;
 - Recommendation students provide a poster to highlight on NEAMGLL website and/or use recording of students presenting at the NAML meeting; need permission.
 - Student awards program details of category of awards;
 - Are the criteria too strict resulting in low numbers of applicants?
 - Criteria Goals: Building networks and community hence the award for student exchange between field stations/marine labs;
 - Fosters collaboration between students working on similar issues; encourage exposure to fresh and marine water systems;
 - Consider instructors apply; create a virtual experience?
 - Need to publish statement on advertisement that F&A is not an eligible budget item on their application;
 - Could presentations be used?
